In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loan/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

- The school will follow the **RTE Act, 2009** and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
- The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
- The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
- The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
- The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws** and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
- The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
- Admission to the school** is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
- The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education.
- The number of sections may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. For Increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation Bye laws.
- The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
- The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc.
- The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in
- The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
- Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- The Manager and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
- Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per clause 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws-2018.
- The genuineness of information / documents / data submitted shall be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall invite action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018
- The school shall be responsible for submission of any pending compliance, reply of show case /legal notice/ complaint and for submission of date/information sought by the Board. The extension of 05 years shall be from the date of cessation of previous validity of extension of affiliation
- The school is required to remit pending fee, if any
- The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure. However, the cases where the Show Cause Notice was communicated or grievance / legal cases are pending against the school, the Board will take appropriate decision in this matter
- The school shall renew all mandatory safety certificate i.e Safe Drinking Water & Health and Hygiene certificate, Fire Safety Certificate and Building Safety Certificate from concerned Govt authorities time to time
- The school shall also maintain record of certificate, compliances, data and other records/information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board and appropriate Government Authorities when asked for, failing which necessary action shall be taken as per Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board. The school shall also be liable for action by the appropriate Govt., in case of violation / non-compliance of the concerned Govt. norms
- The Board reserves the right to conduct inspection of school as per clause 11.2 and 11.4 of Affiliation Bye Laws.

9. Continuous sponsoring of students at board examination is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv).
10. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
11. Running of classes of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
12. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.
13. Health, sanitation and fire safety should be adequately equipped i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (vii), rule 8.5 and rule 23.11.
14. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
15. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-postal and e-mail, telephone nos. etc.
16. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
17. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a Health Wellness teacher as per rule 53.5.
18. Strict adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
19. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of private publishers. The content must be scrutiny preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescribed books having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.

Provisions of Affiliation bye laws for adherence:-

1. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. **No capitation fee or voluntary donations** for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure i.a.w. rule no. 11.1, 2 & 3.
2. The school should not use the activities for **commercialization**:-
 - a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.
 - b) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)a Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
3. Teachers are to be made educated regarding **corporal punishment** & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
4. School will not prepare any student/ start class for **any other Board** except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.
5. **Admission to the school** is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.
6. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from **sexual harassment** at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
7. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame **Service Rules** for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, **Service contract** will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
8. **Pay and allowances** to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government. Further, **Salary and service conditions** of staff should be provided i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (v) and rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
 - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.

7. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.
8. Income & Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year.
9. Other conditions are enclosed as per Annexure 'A'.
10. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-

- a. Renewed Certificate from the concerned Govt. Authorities of the area relating to sanitary conditions of the school, availability of safe drinking water and fire safety arrangements of the school may be obtained and submitted at the earliest.
- b. The school is required to reconstitute the School Managing Committee as per the provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board by including two teachers, parents and Board's nominees in it. In this regard a panel of five Principals (inclusive of at least 2-3 Principals from nearby JNV/KV) be forwarded.
- c. The school is required to create reserve funds in the joint names of Manager of the school concerned and Secretary, CBSE of the Board in accordance with the strength of the students and maintain the same under clause xxiii of Affiliation Bye-laws of the Board.
- d. The School is required to appoint only qualified and trained teaching staff as per norms of the Board. Besides teachers are required to be given prescribed pay scales alongwith DA and other admissible allowances at least at par with the State Govt. pay scales or 6th Pay Commission through ECS. A proof of pay scales disbursing in the school as per the concerned State Govt. notification be submitted in this regard. Besides, a copy of latest staff statement showing details of all the staff i.e. Name, Designation, DOB, Educational Qualification, Experience, Pay scales etc. and latest acquaintance roll showing details of salary being given to the staff, mode of payment of salary with proper deduction of EPF etc. be furnished after doing needful. The same can be checked and verified by the Board at any time.
- e. The Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of First appointment of the teachers on probation. Salary should be transferred in the individual accounts of the staff through ECS. A Certificate from the Banker to the effect that the salaries are credited in the personal accounts of the staff members through ECS with documentary proofs be submitted at the earliest.
- f. The School should have adequate infrastructure including building playground etc. as per Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board.
- g. A documentary proof regarding implementation and regular deduction of EPF is required to be submitted alongwith latest Pay Bill and Bank Challan.
- h. The number of students enrolled is more than 40 in Nursery classes. Therefore enrollment should be restricted with optimum number of 40 students per section as per norms of the Board.
- i. The school library needs to be enriched with more books and periodicals etc.

This is with reference to your online application dated 30.06.2014 on the subject cited above.

In this connection, I am directed to convey sanction of extension of provisional affiliation of the school with the Board for its **Secondary School Examination and Senior Secondary School Examination** for a further period of **Five years w.e.f. 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2020** subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes and senior secondary classes:-

1. The School is required to follow syllabi and course as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for the respective Examination.
2. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board.
3. The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation alongwith the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires. Applications will be accepted after the last date along with the prescribed fee and late fee Rs. 10,000/- per month subject to maximum of Rs. 50,000/-.
4. Provisional Affiliation granted to a school will remain valid on receipt of online application of a school for further extension of provisional affiliation subject to the final decision of the Board. (Amended Rule 15.11).
5. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
6. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII :-

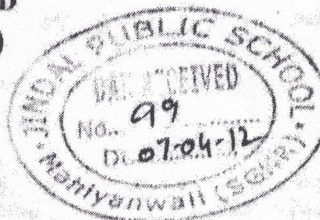

Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 27.06.2011 and subsequent inspection of the school, I am directed to convey sanction for provisional affiliation to the above said school for Senior School Certificate Examination for a period of three years w.e.f. 01.04.2012 to 31.03.2015 in the following subjects:-

- (a) Languages: English Elective.
- (b) Elective Subjects: History, Political Science, Geography, Economics, Sociology, Philosophy, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Education, Business Studies, Accountancy, Agriculture, Computer Science.

The sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes:

1. "The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Senior School Certificate Examination and changes made therein from time to time."
2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board upto Classes X.
As per the newly implemented CCE scheme vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009, the students of class X will appear in the Summative Assessment-II (SA-II) conducted at the school level only. However, those students of class X, who opt to move out of CBSE system in Class XI to any other Board, will exercise the option to appear in the SA-II conducted at the Board level. Both the students will get the same certificate issued by the Board at the end of class X.
4. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt./UT.
5. The school will provide additional suitable facilities for classes XI and XII, as per requirements laid down in the rules.
6. It will increase the number of books in the Library and equipments in the Laboratories/Workshops with adequate games facilities etc. in consonance with the requirements of the Board for Classes XI & XII.
7. It will appoint only qualified staff to teach Classes XI & XII as per requirements laid down by the Board.
8. It will provide facilities for adequate co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the wholesome development of the students.
9. It will abide itself by the Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board and other rules and regulations prescribed by the Board from time to time.
